Goals of Swim Team

Beekman Recreation Aquatics Department offers affordable Red Cross Swimming Lessons & Swim Team so that youth have the opportunity to develop aquatic sports as a lifelong interest and healthy leisure activity.

Tips for Aquatic Activities

- Discourage your swimmer from using nose plugs as they become dependent.
- Apply sunblock 30 minutes before practice to allow the skin to absorb it, otherwise it washes off quickly.
- Review the beach rules with your child before coming to the beach.

Refunds Info

- A full refund will be given for any program canceled by the Recreation Department due to lack of enrollment
- No refunds are made due to acts of God/weather
- All cancellation/refund requests must be in writing
- A prorated refund minus a \$15 Cancellation fee will be applied if a replacement can be found
- A Doctor's note is required prior to the end of the program for requests related to illness or accident

Inclement Weather Beach Policy

- The Beach is closed during inclement weather at the discretion of our staff.
- The beach, mini-golf, volleyball and all outdoor activities are suspended for 30 minutes whenever thunder is heard or lightning is seen; we ask patrons to seek shelter in the pavilion or their cars.
- Swim Team may be moved to dry land training or cancelled at the discretion of our staff
- Changes in the schedule will be posted as an "Alert" on the website home page and on the voicemail on the Park Manager's phone, 845-223-6970
- There are no refunds for inclement weather.



Safety Guidelines

Our swimming area is created by water diverted from the Fishkill Creek. Once in our lake, the water is chlorinated. The Dutchess County Health Department regulates our swimming area and inspects it frequently. In order to comply with the Health Department, we have to maintain four feet of water clarity to open our deep sections.

Periodically, after heavy rains that stir up the creek supplying water to the swimming area, or on heavy beach use days, we may have to temporarily close our deep sections if we do not have four feet of water clarity. The safety of our patrons is our top priority. We apologize for any inconvenience closures may cause and ask for your patience and understanding.

Safety Drill Closures

The beach will be closed at a different time each week for one half-hour so the lifeguards can perform safety drills. Watch your guards in action.

Times

Swim Team practices 4-6pm weekdays. Different age levels will be assigned different times within that two hours:

Ten and under: 4pm Eleven and older: 5pm

Older more experienced swimmers will be Junior Coaches in Training and assist with younger swimmers at 4pm. They may receive Community Service Credit for this.

Rec Department Responsibilities

The Recreation Department will collect and use fees to provide coaches for practices & meets; all other functions of the team must be provided by the Parent Organization.



Parent/Guardian Responsibilities

The Beekers Swim Team operates through a cooperative agreement with the Town of Beekman Rec Department and the Beeker's Parents. In order to maintain our team in these difficult economic times each family **must provide**:

- Parent Service Time: for such things as attendance, bake sales, timing, ribbon writing and tallying, and end of year party
- Fundraising help: to raise money for trophies, ribbons, parties, timers, and other related items
- **Refreshments:** all families are asked to provide items for at least 3 meets' concession
- THREE days advance notice to the coaches if a child is not able to make a scheduled meet
- A responsible adult to get children to and from Swim Practices and Swim Meets and to be present during the same, for youth 12 and under. Our coaches can only be responsible for swim team members when the children are in the docks with the coaches. If a child needs to use the bathroom they will be sent off the docks to find the responsible parent. If the child is 12 or older, the child will be sent alone to the bathroom if the parent is not present. Parents of 12+ children that are not comfortable with this procedure should be present during the program.

Rules

- Youth must be able to swim 25 yds unattended
- Missing multiple practices may result in being scrubbed from meet. This is at the coaches discretion
- Non Team siblings must be supervised at all times
- Any non-swim team members using the lake MUST use the Patron Beach and follow the applicable rules; no one should enter or DISTURB the water in and around the Swim Team Docks
- NO ONE should enter the creek
- Only swim team members in the current practice, and the assigned volunteers and staff are permitted on the docks
- Any children coming to practice from Day Camp must be signed out of Day Camp by a parent/guardian or after care staff
